Dear Secretary Vilsack,

Under your leadership USDA has advanced an impressive record of support and regulatory improvements for the U.S. organic industry. The Organic Transition Initiative and three substantive National Organic Program rulemakings during your tenure will have lasting effects on the organic community as the marketplace continues to grow and evolve.

The department has also been responsive to global supply chain shocks and inflationary pressures that severely disrupted the organic livestock sector.

A commitment of \$104 million for the Organic Dairy Market Assistance Program (ODMAP) and a subsequent sign-up in 2023 has been hugely impactful for small organic dairy farms in the U.S. However, the reality is the initial sign-up of 2023 only spent-out around \$20 million and while timely and necessary, these payments did not adequately reflect the cost dynamics in organic dairy.

The USDA Farm Service Agency leadership recognized this dynamic and has made clear to stakeholders as well as members of Congress that adjustments would be made and another ODMAP sign-up for 2024 was imminent. This commitment inspired hope and confidence in the organic dairy community that USDA was listening to the challenges on-farm and an additional round of support could be expected to enhance the vitality of organic dairy farms.

We receive weekly if not daily inquiries from organic dairy farmers on the status of the program. The need remains apparent in the organic dairy community, and we implore you to bring all focus and attention to making a 2024 ODMAP sign-up a reality.

We stand ready to applaud progress on ODMAP and to ensure organic dairy farmers are aware of the opportunity and support provided by this administration.
